# Four main paths Committees may take:

- 1. Appoint someone who is already in the district.
- 2. Conduct a school committee managed and run search
- 3. Hire a consultant to run the day-to-day aspects
- 4. Hire an interim
  NOTE: In every case,
  the Committee retains
  the search authority.



### School Committees must:


 Abide by the Open Meeting Law (MGL Ch. 32A) in all aspects
